Amazona aestiva

The Blue-Fronted Amazon is part of the large group of parrots that make up the most popular group of pet birds. It has an unusually loving disposition, especially if hand-fed, and will readily interact with humans. It is an excellent mimic of human speech; and many Blue-fronts acquire a very large vocabulary.

Blue-fronts come from the tropical rainforests of northeast Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, and Paraguay and in the wild, tend to explore the upper levels of the canopy. You will want to provide a relatively high cage, and allow this bird to have some time to roam. Be careful of open doors and windows, however. The average cost of a Blue-Fronted Amazon is \$700.
